The Fine Print:

The \$80 deposit that is paid at the time of registration is non-refundable. The future event must be held within one year. Balances are due 60 days prior to the event. Without payment, your spot and deposit may be forfeited. Final payments can only be refunded if we are notified at least 60 days prior to the event or are able to fill your spot. The \$80 deposit would be rolled to a future event. These rules are in place because we have contracts that have to be fulfilled with the venues.
